Next Scrip order due February 2nd

December was our biggest order ever making almost \$300 dollars for Lakeside. Thanks to all who participated.

Lakeside has partnered with the Great Lakes Scrip Center to bring you "scrip" -- negotiable gift certificates that you buy at face value and use at local and national retailers. You can buy things you would have purchased anyway, and a portion of the scrip amount (usually 4-15%) goes back to the school. The list of participating retailers is great -- from discount stores to gas, groceries, drugstores, movie theaters, and high-end retailers.

For the rest of the school year Scrip orders will be due the first Tues. of each month. Download an order form or pick one up at school in the office or on the outside bulletin board and turn it in to the office by February 2nd.

Guinness World Record Attempt

Lakeside students are preparing to join students across the state in a mass attempt to break the Guinness World Record for the "Most People Jumping/Skipping Rope at the Same Time." The current record, 59,000 people, is held by Australia.

At 9 a.m. on February 1st, our students will join thousands of students across the state to simultaneously jump rope for 10 minutes. The California Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance is hoping to include more than 80,000 Californians in this attempt, which is being held in conjunction with the American Heart Association's Jump Rope for Heart campaign. Needless to say, we'll be jumping through January in PE classes!
